

The purpose of the training vehicle is to provide short high impact training sessions for employees on site. This will do away with the need to take people off site for training and therefore will not have as great an impact on production as if people were to leave site.

The training sessions will be short and to the point and will not last longer than 20 – 30 minutes. This will ensure maximum impact and as stated before will have a minimum impact on production. The vehicle will currently be made available for two days per week and will need to be booked at least two weeks in advance.

A booking system will be made available to members early in 2017. It is expected that the vehicle will spend 5 to 6 hours on a site with a timetable allowing for at least 8 training sessions. Each session can accommodate 9 to 12 people.

There will be a nominal fee of R 900, 00 plus VAT charged per training day on site. This equates to around R10,00 per person!

This training will be made available to all of our members sites and will be available to the subcontractors of members.

The types of training that will be made available are as follows:
